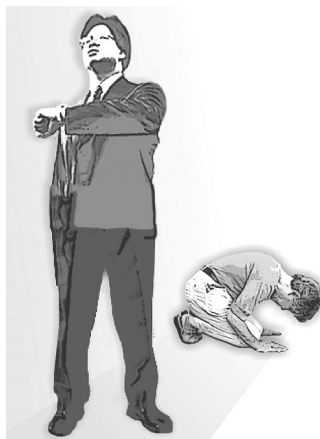
A right Way and a wrong Way to Pray

WORLD MISSION SUNDAY

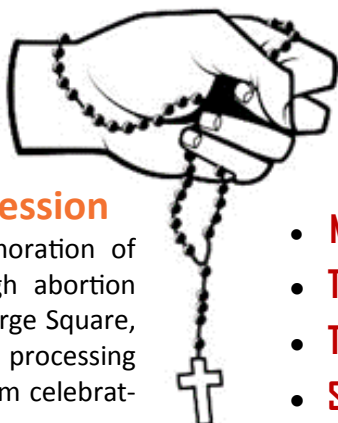

FR PETER'S STREET CHILDREN

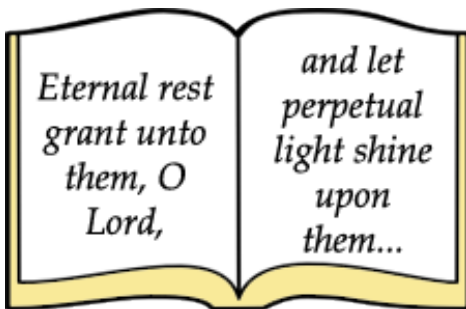

Over 1400 in total were received and submitted to North Lanarkshire Council on your behalf We thank you all for that!
