'MASS OF ST. FRANCIS'

The Diocesan Choir alongside three school choirs (Cathedral Primary, St, Bridget's, Baillieston and St. Cuthbert's, Burnbank) are preparing to put on a performance of the Mass of St. Francis by Philip Green an English born composer who wrote this Mass for adults and children in 1972. He used Matthew 19:14, as the inspiration for the Introit, 'Suffer little children to come unto me' which became very popular in its own right. Some of you may well remember it being sung in many of our schools and parishes in the 1970s. The four choirs will jointly perform the Mass in Motherwell Ca-

thedral at 7.30pm on Thursday 8th June. Philip Green is, of course, the same musician who composed the *Mass of St. Patrick*, performed twice by the Diocesan Choir over the last few years. There will also be guest solo artists. *Please note this is a sacred concert and not a liturgy*.
